

Printable Ring Size Guide

Match a ring you already own, or measure your finger at home.

1 Check the print scale

Lay a credit card over the box. If it fits the outline exactly, the sheet printed at true size.



Why this matters

Ring sizes are separated by less than half a millimeter. A print that is even 3% off will put you a full size out. If the card does not fit the box, reprint at 100% before measuring.

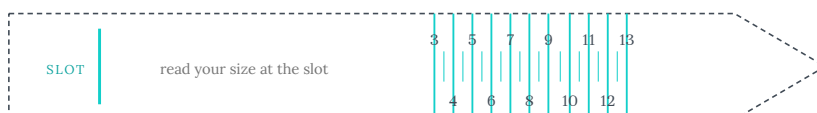
2 Match a ring you already own

Place a ring that fits the intended finger over the circles. The circle that just fills the inside edge of the ring is your size. Between two sizes, choose the larger. Size 7 is the size we stock most.



3 Or cut out the paper sizer

Cut along the dashed outline and the aqua slot. Wrap the strip around the base of your finger, slip the pointed end through the slot, and pull it snug, not tight. It must pass over the knuckle. Read the size at the edge of the slot. Measure late in the day, when fingers are largest.



Odd sizes read above the line, even sizes below. Short ticks are half sizes.
